



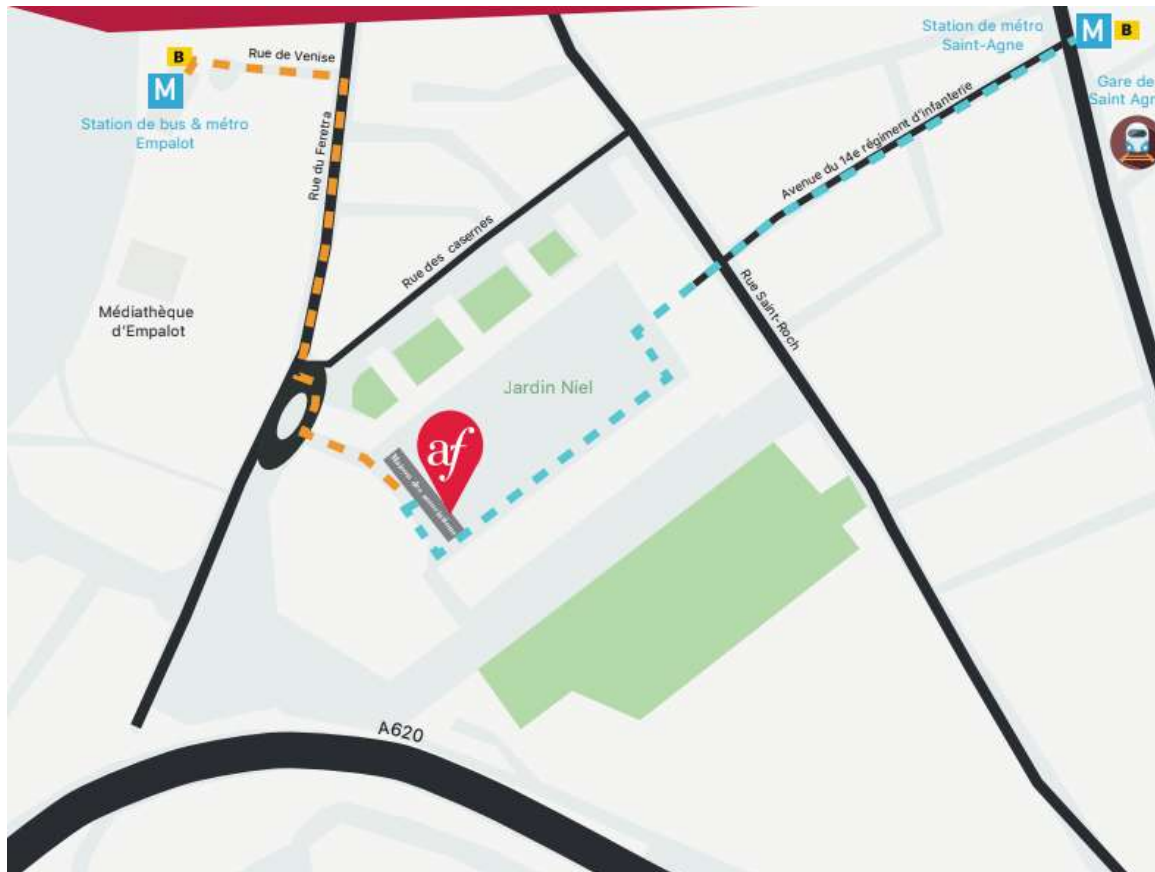

Getting to Alliance Française de Toulouse



Subway: LINE B, EMPALOT or Saint Agne SNCF stations. It takes approximately 7 minutes to walk from these stations to the Alliance Française.



From the Matabiau train station

Take the subway line A, towards Basso Cambo.
Get off at Jean Jaurès to take line B towards Ramonville.
Get off at EMPALOT or SAINT AGNE.

From the airport

Take the T2 tramway to Palais de Justice. Take the subway, line B, towards Ramonville. Get off at EMPALOT or SAINT AGNE.



By car

Take exit 24, towards Empalot, downtown
At the first traffic light, turn right and follow "Maison des Associations". Please note that parking is not free.



Getting to the school

Access to the premises of the Alliance Française is through the entrance of the Maison des Associations, 3 Place Guy Hersant. The entrance to the school is on the second floor and is accessible by elevator or stairs.



Getting to the classrooms

To access the classrooms, students go through the secretariat on the second floor of the Maison des Associations and use the internal staircase of the school. In case of reduced mobility, please contact us to have access to the third floor by elevator.

On the first day of class, it is advisable to arrive early (from 8:30 am). You will find your name, level and classroom number on the notice board.

The reception staff is there to help you if you need anything.

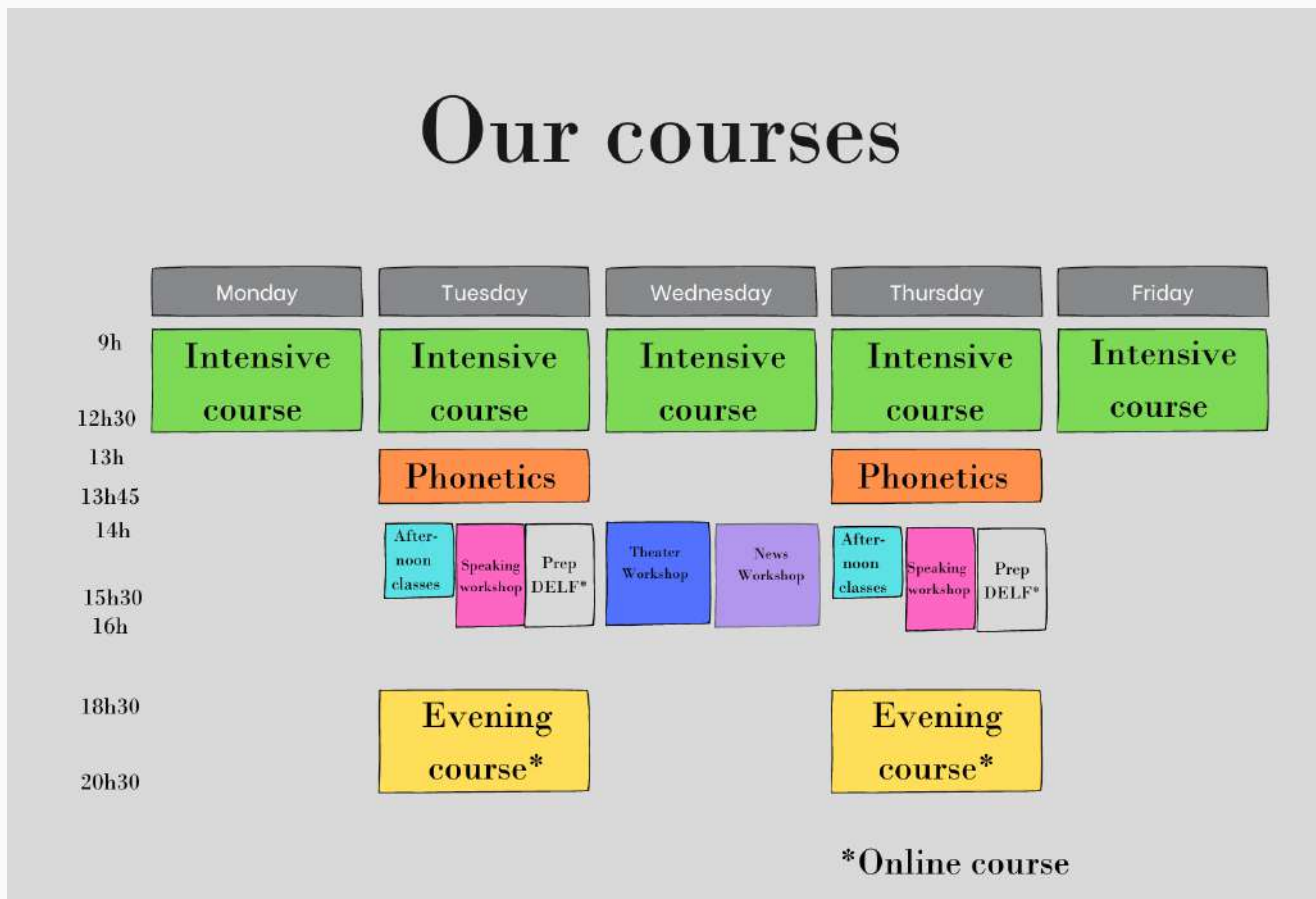
